About the Mausolea

The Our Lady of Sorrows at Cedar Grove Cemetery mausolea complex, named for the patroness of the Congregation of Holy Cross, is located on Notre Dame Avenue at the southern edge of the Uni-



versity of Notre Dame campus. The complex currently includes two open-air garden mausolea. An open-air garden mausoleum has both an interior and an exterior; however, there are no doors. Plans are to build up to eleven (11) total mausolea within the current acreage of the cemetery, to the west of the existing mausolea. The next two mausolea are slated for construction in the spring of 2012.

The existing mausolea are identical in their architecture and construction, offering interior single and companion crypts for the entombment of the full body, as well as interior companion and exterior single and companion niches for the inurnment of the cremated remains of the body. The two mausolea awaiting construction will compliment the existing mausolea, using the same pallet of materials (brick, granite, slate and limestone), however they will be slightly larger and feature a greater variety of full body burial options, in addition to companion niche space. All interment space will reside on the exterior of the building.

Who Can Purchase and Who May be Interred?

Notre Dame alumni or their surviving spouse, children or parents are eligible to purchase interment space for themselves and up to three (3) additional family members (four people total per alum-

nus). Purchase eligibility is also extended to the members of Sacred Heart Parish, Notre Dame, Indiana who have been registered and active for a period of five (5) or more years. Full-time University faculty, staff, and retirees with the requisite years of service are also eligible. Alumni, parishioner or employee status will be confirmed with the appropriate campus office prior to the execution of a Purchase Agreement.

Burial and Memorialization Options

Eligible persons may purchase interment space for themselves and their family members in the following combinations:

Crypts for the Full Body	Niches for the Cremated Remains of the Body
Four (4) single crypts	Four (4) single niches
Two (2) single crypts & one (1) companion crypt	Two (2) single niches & one (1) companion niche
Two (2) companion crypts	Two (2) companion niches

Crypts and niches are sold as Single for the interment of one person, or as Companion for the interment of two individuals, usually husband and wife. A Single features an individual granite shutter for memorialization of one person. A Companion features one united granite shutter for the memorialization of two people. A companion shutter is twice the size of a single shutter. Each line of memorialization is limited to 14 characters and spaces. Below are examples of memorialization:

Pricing and Payment Options

In contrast to many cemeteries, pricing for Our Lady of Sorrows at Cedar Grove Cemetery is inclusive of standard interment and memorialization fees. Interment fees include the opening and closing of a crypt or niche for the purpose of burial. Memorialization fees include the engraving of the last name, first name, middle initial or maiden name, birth year and death year on the granite shutter at the time of need. Memorialization prior to need (also known as pre-memorialization) is available for a nominal fee.

Current space availability and pricing as of the date stamped on the maps is enclosed. **Please note: companion crypt and niche pricing is per space and not per person.**

Cedar Grove Cemetery offers a three-year payment plan for spaces in the existing mausolea. A deposit of 25% is required. Spaces purchased in the new mausolea *prior to the start of construction* are eligible for a five-year payment plan with a deposit of 10%. There are no carrying charges (interest).
